Anna Marie Cipolla, 83, longtime resident of Stamford, CT, passed away in peace at her home on the morning of Thursday, October 9, 2014. She was born “under the 59th Street bridge” in New York, NY on October 30, 1930 to the late Michael and Mary (Guarino) Cipolla.

Born and raised in New York City, Ann attended NYC schools and graduated from Julia Richman High School with the class of 1948.
