Robert T. Clifford (“Bob”) passed away on February 23, 2021. He was born on March 26, 1939 at Jewish Memorial Hospital (Inwood, NY) to Sheila P. (nee Connolly; Balla, Co Mayo, Ire) and Francis Aloysius Clifford (Brooklyn, NY).

Bob graduated from Mount St. Michael Academy and Fordham University where he made precious life-long friendships.
