Agostino Scicchitano, 82, a longtime resident of Stamford, CT, passed away peacefully at his home with his daughters by his side on Saturday, October 11, 2025. He fought his illness bravely. Agostino was born on March 25, 1943 in Girifalco, Italy to the late Cosimo and Caterina Migliazza Scicchitano. He came to the United States at the age of sixteen and became a Stone Mason/Bricklayer.
