Angel Isidro, 94, husband of the late Noemi Isidro passed away peacefully on Monday, November 12, 2018 in Virginia surrounded by his loving family. Angel was born on August 2nd, 1924 in Havana, Cuba. He was the son of Angel Isidro Sr. and Josefa Pombo and was the eldest of their seven children.

Angel graduated from the police academy in Havana and worked for 16 years in various assignments in the National Secret Police prior to the arrival of Communism in Cuba.
