Benito Di Nino of Stamford, Connecticut passed away peacefully on Thursday, August 19, 2021, at the age of 93. He was surrounded by endless love of his wife Angelina and family by his side.

Benito was born in Alanno, Italy on March 17, 1928, to father Sabatino Di Nino and mother Concietta ColAngelo. He was the fifth child of eleven and worked on his family's farm tending to animals, wheat, grapes and olives as a young man while his older brothers fought in WWII. His tireless work ethic and drive to care for his family led him to begin his journey to achieve the "American Dream" with his wife and two young sons.
