Brenda attended Stamford Public Schools graduating from Stamford High School. She received her bachelor's degree in Sociology from Fairfield University. From 1988 to 2006 she worked at International Paper Foundation and her position as Program Officer included the daily management of a multi-million-dollar grant making program. Later she transitioned to Goldman Sachs and Company in New York, NY as a grant manager which led her to a higher position of Vice President of Corporate Engagement. She retired from Goldman Sachs in 2022.

Brenda was predeceased by her mother Barbara M. Lee, father William F. Duncan, her two sisters Valerie D. Lee and Daryl I. Lee, and stepdad James. W Davis. She was the granddaughter of Ferdinand and Esther Beaman Lee of Southampton NY. Those left to forever cherish her memories are her brother Randell L. Duncan, aunts, Florence C. Etheridge and Thelma D. Lee, and numerous cousins, family, friends, and godchildren. Also left to cherish her memory is her best friend Nadine Little who was with her in her final days and hours.
