Chester S. Kryspin, 96, passed away peacefully at home in Oxford, CT on January 28, 2023.

He was born in Stamford, CT on May 18, 1926 to Konstanty and Jadwiga Kryspin. A long time resident of Stamford, Chet attended Holy Name of Jesus School and J.M. Wright Technical School. After graduation, he served his country in World War II as a member of the Army Air Corps. Following his service, he graduated from University of Connecticut where he was a member of Lambda Chi Alpha. He was also a member of Mensa.

After graduation, Chet worked at Kryspin's Market, a family-owned business. Kryspin's Market later merged with Cove Market, at which time Chet was the principal owner until the 1970s. He later worked for the Greenwich law firm, Ivey, Barnum, & O'Mara, as a title searcher.

He is survived by his wife of 56 years, Patricia A. Kryspin. Chet was predeceased by two brothers--Walter and Edmund. In addition to his wife, he is survived by his sister, Victoria Markowski of Suffield, CT and his brother and sister-in law, Edward and Beverly Kryspin of Amherst, VA as well as many nieces and nephews. Chet will always be remembered for his wit, wisdom, and the playful twinkle in his eye.
