Daniel G. Lannon, 59, of Stamford, CT, beloved husband of Cindy Lannon, died unexpectedly on the afternoon of April 5, 2017. Dan was born November 23, 1957 in Lynn, Massachusetts, then lived in Chicago and Boston before settling in Connecticut and ultimately Shippan. He attended and supported his beloved Bowdoin College in Maine before later receiving his MBA from Columbia University in New York. He worked at IBM and various technology startups for over 30 years and was currently self-employed as an investment manager. Dan was an avid traveler, devoted husband, father, and friend. In addition to his loving wife of 32 years, he is survived by his daughters Katherine and Jennifer Lannon; his brothers, John and Thomas Lannon; their wives; his wife's family; and numerous aunts, nieces, nephews, and cousins.
