Denise Ellen Kelly, born October 24, 1959, a lifelong Stamford, CT resident, loving daughter, sister, aunt, great-aunt and friend to many, passed away peacefully into the hands of Our Lord, on January 31, 2025 at home, following a courageous battle with lung cancer.

Denise is survived by her mother, Bea Kelly of Stamford; twin sister, Diane C. Kelly of Stamford; sister, Janice M. Pearson (Roger) of Orleans, MA; and brother, Bryan R. Kelly (Denise) of East Sandwich, MA.
