



## Francis A Chmielinski

Francis Alfred Chmielinski, 85, of Rowayton and longtime resident of Stamford, CT, passed away at his home on Wednesday, August 13, 2014. Francis was born July 4, 1929 in Stamford and was the only child born to the late Francis S. and Bertha L. (Pieczko) Chmielinski.

Francis attended Stamford public schools and graduated from Stamford High School with the class of 1948. Following graduating, he joined the U.S. Marine Corps where he served during the Korean Conflict and achieved the rank of Sergeant. After the service he returned to Stamford and began his career as an automotive mechanic. He married his beloved wife, Dorothy, in 1960 and enjoyed 40 years of marriage until her passing in 2000.
