Frank Anthony Magnoli Jr., a lifelong resident of Stamford, CT, passed away peacefully on January 28, 2025. Born in Stamford on October 2, 1956, he was the beloved son of the late Filomena (Sorbo) and Frank Magnoli Sr.

Frank was a proud graduate of St. Basil's Preparatory School, Class of 1974. He had a deep appreciation for nature and frequently retreated to the Green Mountain forests of Vermont, where he cherished spending weekends at the Magnoli family cabin. He was a devoted New York Yankees fan and shared this passion with his daughter, Josefina. He also loved tending to his garden and found great joy in nurturing plants and watching them thrive.

Frank was preceded in death by his loving parents, Filomena and Frank A. Magnoli Sr. He is survived by his devoted daughter, Josefina Daniello of Bluffton, South Carolina; his brother, Michael, and his wife Jennifer (Sileo) of Norwalk, CT; his nephew, Joseph Magnoli of Norwalk, CT; his niece, Jessica Magnoli of West Hartford, CT. He also leaves behind cherished aunts, uncles, cousins, and loyal friends who will forever hold him in their hearts.
