



## Genevieve K Cal

July 26, 1931 - January 15, 2026

Genevieve K. Cal, 94, passed peacefully at home in Stamford, CT, surrounded by family members, on Thursday, January 15, 2026.

Genevieve was born in Stamford on July 26, 1931 to the late Albina and Izydor Koziol, and was a lifelong resident of Stamford. Genevieve was raised in the South End and attended Holy Name of Jesus School and Stamford High School, graduating in 1948. Shortly after, she began working at Yale & Towne, where she met the love of her life, Genaro Cal. They were married in 1954 at Holy Name of Jesus Church.

While raising her nine children, Genevieve supported the family business, Calko Die Casting Company, as its bookkeeper. Later, she returned to her career full-time, working as a bookkeeper at Palmer's Electric in the South End until the age of eighty.

Genevieve loved gardening. Throughout her life, she could often be found outside tending to her flower beds and garden. She continued with this passion through her final year.

Genevieve was predeceased by her beloved husband of forty-one years, Genaro Manuel Cal, in 1995. She is survived by nine children: John (Helena), Raymond (Mary Mortell-Ferrone), Stanley, Genevieve Schimpfle (George),

Peter (Kristi), Paul (Lynette), Marianne Mahoney (Patrick), Thomas, and Robert (Shana). She was a proud grandmother to twenty-two grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren, each of whom brought her immense happiness.
