



## Gerald Obuchowski

August 30, 1944 - November 7, 2021

Gerald “Jerry” Obuchowski passed away peacefully at Norwalk Hospital, Sunday November 7, 2021 with his wife and eldest grandson by his side. Born on August 30, 1944 in Stamford, CT, Jerry was the son of the late Victor and Catherine Obuchowski.
