



## Gilbert Félien

December 28, 1960 - June 1, 2025

Gilbert Félien, beloved husband and father, returned to the Father's House on Sunday, June 1, 2025. He was 64.

Born in Port-Au-Prince, Haiti, on December 28, 1960, Gilbert was the fourth of 7 children of Ragland Félien and Ternélie Sainvil Félien. He was a quiet, gentle, and great counselor to his siblings and many others of his family circle. From Haiti to the United States, he had been a Credo Catholic, very devoted and engaged. He was a Eucharistic Minister, the leader of the group Laïca, and the Legion of Mary Presidium at St. Charles RC Church in Carrefour, Haiti. He had been an active participant in the Haitian Charismatic Prayer Group at St. Joseph, and a registered member of the St. Joseph and St. Ladislaus Parish in Norwalk, CT. Throughout his time of suffering and struggles, until he breathed his last, Gilbert held strongly to his Christian Faith hoping that the Lord would heal him, while praying to stay on course until the light of Christ brought him to heaven.

After 32 years of marriage, Gilbert left behind to cherish his memory, his wife, Marie Yolène Gilot, their 3 children, Daniel and his wife Francise, Wenchy and Miryam Félien, 1 grandson, Olsen Félien, his 4 brothers Max, Gary, Raoul, and Laurend Félien and a host of in-laws, nephews, nieces, cousins, other relatives, and a great number of friends. He was predeceased by his parents, Ragland and Ternélie, his brother, Jean Robert, and his sister, Yelva, Félien.

Visitation will be held on Friday, June 6th from 9am – 10am at St. Ladislaus RC Church, 25 Cliff Street, Norwalk, CT. A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10am for the repose Gilbert Félien's soul at the Church. Burial will take place at St. John Cemetery, 223 Richards Avenue, Norwalk, CT.
