Helen Ueberbacher, resident of Stamford, CT, passed away peacefully at her home on the evening of Monday, August 6, 2018. Helen was born in LaCrosse, WI on December 2, 1919 to the late Harold and Rosalie (Fraley) Brunk. She was 98 years old at the time of her passing.

Helen graduated from DePaul University in 1942, and went on to earn her Masters from Fairfield University. She concentrated on displaced homemakers for career counseling. She gained business experience in executive offices of local corporations. She was the founder of Learning in Retirement, gathering members for lectures on diverse topics and respectful debates.
