Henry Niewinski, (Hank), a lifetime resident of Stamford, CT and recent resident of Vero Beach, FL passed away unexpectedly on May 29, 2018. Born on July 26, 1938, Hank was the son of the late, beloved Frances and father Joseph Niewinski. He was raised in Stamford, CT and worked at Pitney Bowes until he retired, nearly 40 years later.

Hank was a skillful fisherman on the waters of Long Island Sound. He could be found year round on most early mornings down at Cove Island Marina with his fisherman friends.
