It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Jean Pierre S. Catulle Merisca on October 3, 2024, at the age of 94. Born on August 8, 1930, in Fonds-Verrettes, Haiti, to Celicia and DeMescael Catulle Merisca. Soines was the second of ten children.

He lived a long life defined by faith, hard work, and devotion to his family and community. After completing his schooling, Soines worked as an electrician and later served as a tax collector for the Haitian government.

He married Bernadette Napaul, and together they raised seven children. In the 1960's, in search of greater opportunities for his family, he moved to Stamford, Connecticut. In America, he worked diligently to provide for his loved ones. He became a US Citizen in the 1980's, and, held positions at Greenwich Hospital and The Baptist Church where he served faithfully for 48 years.

A God-fearing man, Soines dedicated his life to his faith and the service of others. Before becoming a charter member of The First French-Speaking Baptist Church on Adams Avenue, he hosted church services in his home. His passions included taking long walks, reading, making friends around town, listening to the radio, and keeping up with the news through newspapers.

He is survived by his loving wife of 42 years, Talie, and their children; Naomie, Roberto, Magalie, and Watson. His legacy also lives on through his grandchildren; Cora, Justin, Karalyn, Christina, Madison, Brandon, and Kayley. Soines is also survived by his uncle, Orel Paul, his siblings; Arthur, Natalie, Saintanne, and Dieulaine, and numerous nieces, nephews and cousins. Four siblings and three of his children preceded him in death, but his memory and influence will continue through those who remain.

Soines will be remembered for his wisdom, compassion, and tireless dedication to his family and community. May his soul rest in eternal peace.
