



## Jon Giancola

October 25, 1959 - November 22, 2021

Jon “Jonny G” Giancola, 62, passed away on Monday, November 22, 2021 at Saint Camillus Convalescent Home in Stamford, after a short, but courageous battle with cancer. Born October 25, 1959 in Stamford, he is the son of the late Nicholas L. Giancola Sr, and Rose Ottanio Giancola.
