October 18, 1955 - March 29, 2021

Justin Cassamajor passed away unexpectedly at home on Monday, March 29, 2021 at the age of 65. He was born in Anse-A-Veau, Haiti on October 18, 1955 to Idelcia Cassamajor and the late Roselin Cassamajor. Justin completed his primary education at Ecole Des Frères De Saint Anges in Anse-a-Veau, followed by secondary school at Lycee Toussaint in Port-Au-Prince.

In November 1980, Justin migrated to America in search of a better life for himself and his extended family and settled in Stamford, Connecticut. Justin made many sacrifices and worked tirelessly to make it possible for his mother, daughter, brothers and sisters to migrate to America. This was followed by the migration of his siblings' extended families to include his brother-in-law; sisters-in-law and nieces and nephews. It was a dream come true for Justin to have his family reunited in Stamford. He was the anchor from which all of us came here and built our lives in America as we continue to grow and extend our own families. It is on his shoulders that we all stand today as successful individuals.

Prior to his passing Justin was gainfully employed at Student Transportation of America as a school bus driver and union Vice Chairperson for over 21 years. Justin's greatest love, next to his family, were the many vinyl records he enjoyed listening to. Justin is now reunited in heaven with his departed father

and younger brother Clebert Cassamajor. He is survived by his mother Idelcia Cassamajor, his daughter Puylaurens Cassamajor Alexis, and husband Reginald Alexis, along with his grandsons: Brayden and Ethan Alexis. He is also survived by Lortune Carolus, brothers and sisters, Kelita Victorin, Capner Cassamajor, Yves Cassamajor, Guy Cassamajor, Dr. Kettly Cassamajor, Kurt Cassamajor and their spouses, along with numerous aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, great nieces and nephews, cousins, co-workers and friends. Justin was loved by many and will be missed more than words can say.

Justin Cassamajor est décédé subitement à la maison le lundi 29 mars 2021 à l'âge de 65 ans. Il est né à Anse-A-Veau, Haïti le 18 octobre 1955 de Idelcia Cassamajor et de feu Roselin Cassamajor. Justin a terminé ses études

primaires à l'Ecole des Frères de Saint Anges à Anse-à-Veau, puis au lycée Toussaint à Port-au-Prince.

En novembre 1980, Justin a émigré aux Etats-Unis d'Amérique à la recherche d'une vie meilleure pour lui et sa famille et s'est installé à Stamford, Connecticut. Justin a fait de nombreux sacrifices et a travaillé sans relâche pour permettre à sa mère, sa fille, ses frères et sœurs de migrer aux Etats-Unis, suivi par la migration de la famille élargie de ses frères et sœurs pour inclure son beau-frère; ses belles-sœurs et ses nièces et ses neveux. C'était un rêve devenu une réalité pour Justin de réunir sa famille à Stamford. Il était l'ancre à partir de laquelle nous sommes tous venus ici et avons construit nos vies en Amérique tout en continuant à grandir et à étendre nos propres familles. C'est sur ses épaules que nous avons tous réalisé nos succès individuels.

Avant son décès, Justin a travaillé pour Student Transportation of America en tant que chauffeur d'autobus scolaire et vice-président du syndicat pendant plus de 21 ans. Justin est maintenant réuni au paradis avec son père décédé et son jeune frère Clebert Cassamajor. Il laisse dans le deuil sa mère Idelcia Cassamajor, sa fille Puylaurens Cassamajor Alexis et son mari Reginald Alexis, ainsi que ses petits-fils: Brayden et Ethan Alexis. 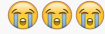
