Kenneth Joseph Downer, 83, a loving husband, father, brother, uncle and friend to many, passed away peacefully at Stamford Hospital on Friday, September 23, 2016 with his family by his side. Ken was born October 12, 1932 in White Plains, NY and was one of five children born to the late Sherman and Katherine (Cuddy) Downer. The two most important things to Ken were faith and family. He grew up in Mamaroneck, New York and began working at a very young age with his father at Playland, a second home to him for 60 years. Ken proudly served his country in Germany from 1954 to 1956 as a member of the United States Army. He later joined the Greenwich Police force making many lifelong friends among colleagues and the community. While at Playland, Ken managed the pool, the ice rink and the park over the years – known as Uncle Kenny not only to his family but to many others who worked there. Ken spent many hours enjoying sports, whether it was his beloved Mets, UCONN basketball, or Notre Dame football he could always be found cheering them on with whoever wanted to join him. A bowler for many years, Ken played in leagues with his son, Kenny, in the Men and Boys League and later in the Visitations League. Ken is survived by his devoted wife of 53 years, Patricia, nee Delaney, his three beloved children; Karen Downer-Doyle (Patrick), Kathleen Solecki (Michael) and Kenneth Downer, Jr. (Victoria), five grandchildren; Ryan, Sean, Kenny, Kyle and Thomas, sister, Virginia, sister-in-laws, Kathleen Delaney and Norma Downer, and many nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents, Kenneth was preceded in

death by his siblings; Mary Jane Recher, Sherman Downer and Nancy Collins.
