Kevin Dennis Sherwood was born on December 11, 1945 in Stamford, CT and passed away on February 15, 2026 in Stamford. He was predeceased by his father, Dr. Frank W. Sherwood and his mother, Margaret M. Sherwood.

Kevin was a lifelong resident of Darien, CT, graduating from Darien High School in 1965. He majored in Political Science and History at the University of Connecticut, graduating with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1970.

He pursued a business career at the University of Bridgeport, earning a Master's Degree in Business Administration in 1973. He worked corporately, over the next ten years, with Garrity Industries, Eaton Corp, and Purdue Frederick as an Account Executive, until they relocated to the South.

In the early 1980's he switched to outdoor sales with Interstate Supply, Duke Mill Supply in Westchester and then locally with Overhead Door until his retirement.

Kevin was a talented accordion player and a self-taught paint artist and furniture restorer, often reimaging the piece. In his free time, he collected stamps and antiques of other memorabilia.

To know Kevin was to quickly appreciate his sharp wit and good humor. His personality was larger than life, living from one joke to the next and putting the

listener in a spasm of laughter. He was unapologetically himself.
