Laura Brach passed away peacefully on May 16, 2023. She was born January 9, 1922 in Bridgeport, CT. Around the age of 8 her family returned to Poland where she lived until 1946, when she returned to US on the Liberty ship USS Ernie Pyle after the end of WW II.

She lived in Stamford, CT for the next 73 years and was an active member of Holy Name of Jesus Church in Stamford. In her earlier years she was a member of the church choir as well as the Rosary Society.

In her later years she was a member of the Senior Circle and looked forward to the Wednesday afternoon gatherings and bingo. She was a devout Catholic and for many years was a daily communicant.

Laura worked briefly at Yale and Towne Co. where she met Cyprian "Cy" Brach whom she married in September 1950. They were married for 54 happy years. She later worked as a saleswoman at Gimbels for 11 years in Women's Fine Dresses. Laura was a devoted mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, and an avid gardener. She was also a talented knitter and crocheter.
