We are sad to announce the passing of Laurence (Larry) Joseph Hayes of Stamford, CT. He died peacefully on April 30 at the age of 87. Larry was originally from Tipperary, Ireland. He immigrated to the U.S. at age 19.

He was married to Eileen McNamara Hayes, who predeceased him. Larry is also predeceased by two children that died during pregnancy; his parents, Patrick Hayes and Anne Ryan Hayes, and his brother Patrick Hayes.
