March 6, 1946 - November 22, 2021

Lee Penfield Trudeau, born and raised in Stamford CT March 6, 1946 passed away peacefully on November 22, 2021 with her family by her side.

Daughter of and predeceased by Richard Penfield II and Ruth Michael, Lee is predeceased by her loving husband of 52 years, Charles "Chuck" Henry Trudeau who passed away in October 2019.

Lee is survived by her 3 children: Christopher Charles Trudeau (Darcey Agostino Trudeau), Emily Sarah Ray (Bruce Ray), Andrew James Trudeau (Jennifer Booth Trudeau) and 7 grandchildren, Zachary, Chloe and Julianna Trudeau, Kayla and Naomi Ray and Surrey and Felix Trudeau. Lee is also survived by her siblings Mary Dana White, Kathe Simons, Richard Penfield, and Anne Penfield.

Lee graduated from American University in 1969 with a degree in psychiatric nursing. After her marriage to Chuck, Lee lived in NY state, Puerto Rico, Chicago, Illinois and spent 8 ½ years overseas in Croydon, England prior to returning to her hometown of Stamford, CT in 1981. While in England she was introduced to several breeds of dogs that initiated a passion with her husband for showing and breeding purebreds. They fell in love with the West Highland White Terrier. Through her love and passion for the breed Lee met people from all over the country with the same passion forming a network of close

friends. Lee was a founding member of the West Highland White Terrier Society of Connecticut and served on numerous committees on the National Westie club as well as performing many duties such as organizing annual fundraising auctions and contributing to the Westie Imprint magazine and monthly e-newsletter.

In addition to her love of breeding and showing Westies, Lee worked for several years as a floral designer with her brother Richard at Latham's Florist in Stamford and was a member of the daughters of the American Revolution. Lee also developed lasting friendships with many of the clients for whom she groomed their Westies on a regular basis. Lee had a passion for needlepoint, her beloved New York Mets, summers on Cape Cod and her seven grandchildren who she simply adored.

Lee will be immensely missed by all who knew and loved her. She exuded empathy, had a dry wit and an open heart to all who came into her life.

To celebrate Lee's life, visiting hours and a memorial service will be held at Bosak Funeral Home, 453 Shippan Ave, Stamford, CT on December 4, 2021. Visitation hours will be from 1 to 3 pm. “ Dear Trudeau Family,
In March 2009 we lost our beloved Westie, Kiltie. I was crushed and we just could not think about moving forward and simply “replacing” Kiltie – she was family. However, in late 2011 one of our friends who knew we were missing our Kiltie was sitting in Dr Duffy’s waiting room when your Dad brought in one of the Trudeau team Westies, introduced herself and got Chuck’s contact information. My wife, Irene, called, spoke to your Mom and arranged a time to come over and meet the Trudeau family, both two and four legged. After meeting and spending time with your Mom and Dad and the gang – especially Olivia, the notion that we were not replacing Kiltie but starting a new chapter and adventure with a special Westie pup emerged. This was entirely due to the warmth, kindness and commitment of Lee and Chuck. We waited and when Olivia had her litter in May of 2012, we learned we would get one of the pups. We didn’t get to choose – Lee and Chuck did that, and it turned out to be the best thing that could ever happen to us because they matched us with Maggie- Pippa’s sister – our third Westie. Lee and Chuck changed our lives by picking a magical dog and she is interwoven into every aspect of our lives. Maggie reflects the commitment, kindness, thoughtfulness, love, gentle spirit, and intelligence that exists in the Trudeau household. It was always fun to bring Maggie to Lee for a grooming. Chuck would show a new project/diorama he was working on and the conversations would include war history, politics and matters family and Westie. We would send Lee a running log of Maggie’s adventures. Lee knew that one of our daughters, Mary, wanted a Westie and we were hopeful it might be one of Pippa’s pups as Lee spoke about breeding her again. But this was not to be. So last August Lee introduced Mary to Diana Spivey and now Mary has a wonderful 15 week old Westie pup of her own - Ripley.
Chuck and Lee were a great team, and they had a passion for their family. Their commitment to the West Highland breed has made a difference. Lee pushed on bravely, with spirit and poise after Chuck’s passing. We are so very sad that she now has left. But together Lee and Chuck have made a difference to so many people

in breeding so many glorious little pups that not only represent the breed so well but most importantly brought true love and joy into so many lives. This is so very special.
