Lwidji Brun was born to Berthony and Marie Irmine Brun December 31, 1988 in Port-au-Prince, Haiti.

Lwidji migrated to the U.S. as a young adolescent. He received his high school education at Westhill High School. At the age of 32, Lwidji was murdered on May 18, 2021 in his home of residence in Stamford, CT. While at Stamford Hospital, Lwidji succumbed to his injuries and his spirit went to be with the Lord God; his mother, Marie and grandfather, Mauril Lauture.

Lwidji was a humble and quiet individual. Growing up, he was very shy. Often observing the crowd or having simple one-on-one conversations. He enjoyed laughing, often joking with his younger cousins. He enjoyed spending time playing video games or sports with his family and close friends. He loved music. There was never a moment where he was not listening to music via speaker or headphones.

Lwidji was passionate about those he loved most. He valued family over everything. He was a sensitive and loving son and father. He loved his daughter immensely.

Lwidji is survived by his daughter, Cecilia Brun; his significant other, Latoya Person; his father, Berthony Brun; and his siblings, McKleeffens and

Chrismine Brun. He is also survived by several close aunts and uncles, cousins, and 2 nieces who will miss him dearly.
