Margaret graduated from St. John's Hospital Nurses Training and proudly served as a Registered Nurse for many years. She completed advanced training in Coronary Care in a program that was considered equal to the most sophisticated and advanced units in the country at that time. She valued this as her greatest professional accomplishment and her skills as a nurse were never far from her thoughts.

Marge married the love of her life, Frank on February 22, 1960 who she met commuting by train to high school when she was just 15 years old. They enjoyed 65 years together, married 57.

In time, she joined her husband Frank in building a successful graphic design firm where her artistic talents and keen business skills were able to be expressed.
