January 25, 1931 - January 15, 2017

Maria Szulimowski, passed away on Sunday, January 15, 2017 at the age of 85. She was born in Poland on January 25, 1931 to the late Joseph Kral and Julia Baum. During the war, she was taken to a work camp in Germany. When the war ended, she remained in Germany where she later met and married her beloved husband Bronislaw Szulimowski in 1948. The following year, emigrated to the US in search of a better life. After working as farm laborers in Chicago and Tennessee, in 1951, they moved to Stamford, CT and started a family. Maria was very active in the Holy name of Jesus Church and enjoyed baking and cooking for many of the church functions.
