“ Fred, Tom, Kathy, Jack, Jimmy and family: I will always remember Mary as my first babysitter who cared for us McAuliffe cousins with a ready smile and a patient way. When we lived in Glenbrook, she was like a big sister to us and another daughter to Tim and Millie. After our move to Springdale, I remember she loved coming to Minivale Road for family picnics and parties and also just to relax in the backyard when her own children were toddlers. I have so many fond memories...but the most significant is when we would gather for holidays at Aunt Dottie's on Shippan Avenue... that sunken living room became a dance floor as she and Fred would move in effortless rhythm as they entertained us all. For me, it was like watching a live American Bandstand. I was so envious of their "moves" and I never could master it...but that was because Mary and Fred moved as one. No hesitation...safe with each other. When Mary lived on Ursula Place, I would go down to their apartment and help her with the boys...especially the summer she was expecting Kathy. I remember playing on the front stoop, and watching the parade of kids up and down the sidewalk. I observed what a great mother she was... strict, but kind...funny and caring, always putting the needs of her family first. She took pride in her home...it was as spotless as Aunt May's shiny floor at the firehouse, which wasn't that easy with active toddlers who had boundless energy. I still recall being instructed on cleaning a porcelain sink with Ajax... scrubbing until it would shine. And then graduating to the bathtub upstairs when I had passed the test. We washed clothes in the machine in the kitchen to hang out back to dry. And I was tasked with sweeping the steps and front sidewalk. I learned a lot those summers...even when I didn't realize it. The year of the 1976 Bicentennial was such fun. Mary was an instigator and decided that we needed to have a huge family reunion and celebration on Minivale Road. The planning parties were endless as all details were hammered out, including all of the silver stars that were made for each family to hang from the huge tent....I still have mine....with the result that we had a great family gathering that week. The years since saw many happy times and also some sad ones as we said our goodbyes to loved ones. While we all are scattered across the

country, with families of our own and responsibilities that have taken us from our Stamford roots, the memories of those cousin times remain strong. I am saddened that I will not be with our beloved family as we say our farewell to Mary. I will be thinking of her and reliving those fun memories. I am certain that she is up in heaven...reunited with those she loved, and looking down at her family gathered in her honor with love and pride. With love.... laleen
