Matilda Serafin Jaworski, a life-long resident of Stamford, died peacefully on Thursday, October 17, 2023 at the age of 98. She was born on March 23, 1925 to the late Anthony Serafin and Frances (Romsky).

Over the years, she and her beloved husband Stanley, enjoyed dancing and spending time together. Stanley predeceased Matilda in 1997.

Known to many as Tilly and Aunt Tee, Matilda was one of six sisters: Genevieve (Anthony) Piorkowski, Irene (Joseph) Koczeniak, Julie (Adolf) Baran, Adele (Ted) Gill, and Eleanor (Edmund) Rotkewicz. She was offered a job with Pitney Bowes after graduation, was a member of the Oval Club, and worked for Pitney Bowes her entire 47-year career. Matilda had a head for numbers all her life.

She was a life-long member of Holy Name of Jesus Church, which she supported with donations for Easter and Christmas Flowers and The Annual Bishop's Appeal throughout her life.
