Raymond Paul Dalesio, Jr., loving husband, father, brother, uncle and friend of many, passed away suddenly at his home in Norwalk on Wednesday, September 21, 2016. Ray went to Stamford High and graduated in 1973. After graduating, he joined the United States Navy. 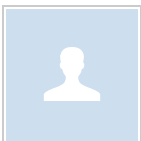
