February 21, 1937 - May 10, 2015

Father Robert J. Hyl, served the Diocese of Bridgeport for over 50 years, passed away peacefully on May 10, 2015. He was born on February 21, 1937 in Byram, Greenwich, CT to Joseph and Vilma (Turcer) Hyl.

Father Hyl was the Pastor the Church of the Holy Spirit in Stamford for many years. He also served as Pastor of Notre Dame Church in Easton. Prior to that, he served many other parishes throughout the Bridgeport Diocese. He loved to travel and travelled extensively throughout the world. He was also an avid reader. Shortly before his death Father Bob told us that "My life had been a total joy because I love my work and if you love your work you will never have a bad day in your life."

He is survived by a sister, Patricia Hyl Moore and her husband, Francis Moore of Sutton, MA; a brother, Kenneth Hyl and his wife Lori Fox Hyl of Brookfield, CT; and by many nieces and nephews: Dennis Hyl and Robin Hyl Lancer, Michael Moore, Kevin Moore, Kathleen Moore Lutz, Thomas Moore, John Moore, Timothy Moore, Terence Moore and Christopher Moore.
