



Russell C. Hahn

July 7, 1947 - January 18, 2020

Russell C. Hahn, a resident of Stamford, CT for the past 15 years, husband of Cynthia (Wiechmann) Hahn, passed away on Saturday January 18, 2020 at the age of 72 after a courageous battle with cancer.

Born in New York City, son of the late Leonard C. and Frances Hahn, he was raised in Nanuet, New York where he attended Clarkstown High School and graduated in 1965. Russ attended Wagner College, Luther Bible College and Newberry College before joining the National Guard 101st Signal Battalion out of Orangeburg, NY and proudly serving his country from 1970 – 1976. His work as a manufacturing supervisor with Nestle Foods brought him and his wife to New Milford Connecticut where he started his family and lived for over 32 years, raising his children and volunteering with the Cub Scouts as Pack Master.

He was an avid reader, gardener and lifelong learner and could often be found outdoors or in his woodworking shop building or fixing something. Russ spent the majority of his career in the residential home building and improvement industry, first as a small business owner and then as a sales person of millwork and building materials. After moving to Stamford, CT, he continued his journey in his Faith through his volunteering as a Trustee and as a member at Trinity Lutheran Church. He retired from WindowRama in 2012 and enjoyed traveling and exploring the Northeast.

Besides his wife Cynthia, he is survived by her sons Daniel and Christopher Jack of Stamford, CT; his daughter Michelle Mitchell of Newington, CT; his son Steven and his wife Gwen Hahn of Avon, CT and his first wife and Mother of his children Janet Hahn of Farmington, CT; his brother Lawrence Hahn and his wife Lynn of Valley Cottage, NY and their son Craig. Russell was also blessed with four beautiful grandchildren, Courtney and Emily Mitchell and Tyler and Cole Hahn.
