She produced intricate flower embroidery and decoupage pictures. She collected furniture, sewed, and loved decorating with her favorite color beige. She was always seen with the family dogs, Sandy at her side or caring for Roxy and her 10 pups. She had a quiet, graceful presence. As a mother, she always encouraged her children to strengthen their minds, never criticized, and always gently guided. Praying and kissing her loving rosary, she was comforted by the home visits from many Holy Name Church priests over the past few years. She is survived by her loving children Laura Rosa, Bernard Daraz, Alfreda Blazey, and Annata Daraz, 8 grandchildren, 4 great grandchildren, her sister Idela Skrzypkowska, and
