Stanley Edward Siecienski, a longtime resident of Stamford, CT, passed away peacefully at his home in Stamford on the morning of Tuesday, January 24, 2017 surrounded by his loving family. He was 83 years old. Stanley was born on October 8, 1933 and was one of three sons of the late John and Julia (Bastura) Siecienski.
